Will my child have an Induction Day?

Yes, Induction Day is Thursday 27th June 2024. There will be an extended Induction programme on Wednesday 4th September whereby Year 7 will be the only year group in.

Will there be an Induction Evening for parents?

Induction Evening will also be on Thursday 27th June 2024.

How are the children set?

We have mixed ability classes in all subjects.

I was wondering what are the rules on school bags? Can it be a tote type bag or does it have to be a backpack?

The majority of our students choose to wear a backpack to School which we would recommend as the most practical way of carrying everything they need around School.

Will my child get lost?

We are an easy to navigate site with only two main buildings. Students will be given a map but will quickly find their way around.

How do we pay for lunches?

All students will have an account using biometric technology (finger prints). As parents you can top this up. We do not accept cash.

What subjects will my child be taught?

Your child will be given a 2 week timetable which explains all subjects that they will be taught. They will be taught in separate rooms with specialist teachers.

What enrichment opportunities are available?
